Chaperone Policies

- Youth may not attend the conference unless accompanied by an Adult Chaperone.
- Chaperone Ratio:
 - A group must have at least one (1) Adult Chaperone for every ten (10) youth, *of the same gender*.
 - A group is permitted to have no more than two (2) Adult chaperones for every ten (10) youth, *of the same gender*.
 - Priests do not count as chaperones.
- An Adult Chaperone must be at least 21 years of age.
- Every Adult Chaperone (including priests) must complete a Liability Form AND an Adult Chaperone Verification Form, signed by the Safe Environment Coordinator of your home diocese.
- A Group Leader is also an Adult Chaperone, and thus counts toward the Chaperone Ratio and all the same required forms.

Chaperone Responsibilities

- Read and be responsible for all Rules, Regulations, Policies, and Practices stated in the Group Leader Information Packet and all posted signage pertaining to the conference on the campus of Franciscan University.
- Assist the Group Leader in ensuring that all youth follow the rules, regulations, policies, and practices stated in the Group Leader Information Packet and all posted signage pertaining to the conference on the campus of Franciscan University.
- Attend to the needs of the youth throughout the duration of the conference weekend.
- Lead small groups
- Complete a Liability Form and an Adult Chaperone Application/Verification Form.
