**Retreat Track**

At the St. John Bosco Conference, the Retreat Track's purpose is not to teach people how to do retreats, but simply to invite lay ecclesial ministers (especially those who have gone through other tracks at our Conference) to *be blessed* with a wonderful retreat -- focused on *spiritual formation and spiritual council for their souls*. In short, this is a retreat experience nested within the Bosco Conference. Those in this track will be able to attend the wonderful liturgies and keynotes already built into the Conference, and will have access to key people chosen to lead this track who will offer personal spiritual counsel and guidance through individual sessions over the course of the week. We cap this track's registration at 20 people, to allow us to serve participants very well and individually. We hope this year will be a gift to your soul!

In addition to the general session speakers, there are four workshops for Retreat Track participants.

These presenters will be available for individual spiritual guidance sessions. Also available for spiritual guidance sessions will be other spiritual directors. Workshop sessions 4, 5 and 6 are intentionally unfilled, which gives track participants greater space to pray, and additional room for us to meet with you.
