- Priests are <u>not</u> required to submit an Adult Chaperone Application/Verification Form, as the "Letter of Good Standing" will be submitted in its stead.
- You may use the below letter (p.2) to request the required "Letter of Good Standing" for your priest.
- If you wish to bring a priest and the above noted deadline for the "Letter of Good Standing" has already passed, please contact us directly by calling 740-284-5888 so that we may assist you in the best way possible.
- See the 2019 Group Leader Information Packet or pgs. 2 and 3 for "Letter of Good Standing" requirements.
- Liability Forms are collected via the Liability Platform. Group Leaders are responsible for sending all priest in attendance with their group the specific group link.

Priests may assist with the below Sacraments throughout the weekend by signing up for desired time slots. Signups will take place Friday evening of the conference.

- <u>Reconciliation</u>: For the good of the youth in attendance and to help them in understanding the great mercies of God, we asked for your help and your time to hear Confessions throughout the weekend.
 - Please help us by signing up for as many time slots as you can in order to serve as many youth as possible.
 - We sincerely thank you for your service and for your beautiful testimony. We honestly could not have successful conferences without your diligent work. As a sign of our gratitude, we have waived the registration fee for all priests in attendance.
 - Please bring your own alb and stole, as we may not have enough to accommodate everyone.
- <u>Concelebrating Mass</u>: All vesting for Mass will take place in the Racquetball Court, located in the Finnegan Fieldhouse.

Dear Your Excellency, Chancellor, Provincial, or Diocesan Representative,

We, the Christian Outreach Office at Franciscan University of Steubenville, facilitate the Steubenville Conferences. We graciously ask for your assistance in order to be compliant with the requirements promulgated by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops' for granting faculties to priests visiting from other dioceses to assist in serving our conference guests in the sacrament of reconciliation and allowance to con-celebrate liturgies.

Additionally, in accordance with the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops' and Franciscan University's Policy for the Protection of Minors, all priests must provide a Letter of Good Standing. The Letter of Good Standing must be written on diocesan letterhead and signed by the Bishop or approved designated representative. The letter must be addressed as follows: "*Dear Franciscan University of Steubenville and the Chancellor of Canonical Affairs.*" The Letter of Good Standing must include the following certifications (See a Sample Letter of Good Standing attached):

- 1. That the cleric is in good standing and is of good character and reputation and qualified to perform his pastoral duties.
- 2. That the cleric has never been suspended or otherwise canonically disciplined.
- 3. That no criminal charges have ever been brought against the cleric nor does he have a criminal record.
- That the cleric has never behaved in such a way as to indicate that he might deal with minors or adults in an inappropriate manner.
- 5. That the cleric does not have a current untreated alcohol or substance abuse problem.
- 6. That the cleric does not have a current, untreated emotional or mental health problem.
- 7. That the cleric has never been involved in any incident which called into question his fitness or suitability to fulfill the responsibilities and duties of his pastoral ministry.
- 8. That the cleric has, as mandated by the Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, participated in an approved training session on how to provide a safe environment for children and young people.
